## CURRICULUM

After my degree in oboe I decided to deepen my knowledge in singing, a passion inspired by my years spent in youth choirs and ensembles during my studies at the conservatory. Once I get my Master degree in Vocal Performance, I left oboe to dedicate myself to singing and in particular to realize my dream of working as a professional chorus singer. I really enjoy to sing in choir, from small ensembles a cappella specialized in Renaissance music, to Baroque ensembles with ancient instruments, as well as in big choirs in symphonic repertoire with orchestra. I spent five years in Dijon Opera Choir as a permanent chorus singer and I decided to quit the position because I missed to sing symphonic repertoire and I wanted to keep diversifying my music experience. My low voice led me to fall in love with Baroque repertoire in which I specialize, but I enjoy singing musics from Renaissance to Contemporary by applying the good practice in each repertoire and style.

I participated as a chorus singer at some of the most important festivals in Europe (Salzburg, Utrecht, Bruges, Milan and Turin, Innsbruck, Féstival Berlioz, and others). As chorus singer and as a soloist I recorded for Deutsche Harmonia Mundi, Decca, Glossa, Hyperion.
